# letters, names, or sight loords 

Swat it! can be used many ways: with letters, with student names, and with sight words. Print and laminate the fly letters, fly swatters, and word cards.

Directions:
Letters:
Students spread out the fly letters. Students take turns identifying a letter and swatting it with the fly swatter.
OR
Students make a stack of lowercase letter cards and spread out the uppercase fly letters. Then flip over a lowercase letter card, swat the matching uppercase card, and set the pair to the side. Play until all the letter cards have a pair.

They place it on their board and READ it. Then BUILD the word/letter with fly letters. Last, they swat it, read it (and spell the word).
Optional recording pages included.
Words (sight words or student names):
Students pick a word card and make the word with the fly letters. Then read the word and say/swat the letters.
