



Articulation: Say your word and then roll a dice! Color in a taco in that row - which row will win?!?

COLORS - PROMPTS FOR PARENTS




Color Labeling: Point to a color and ask your child "what color is it?:

Shape Identification: Ask your child "touch the circle", "touch the heart" etc.


Shape Labeling: Point to a shape and ask your child "what shape is it?


Matching: Go on a shape hunt around the house and find shapes


Hands on: Work together to form playdoh into the different shapes





Hands on: Spread flour on a baking sheet and use finger to make shapes


